

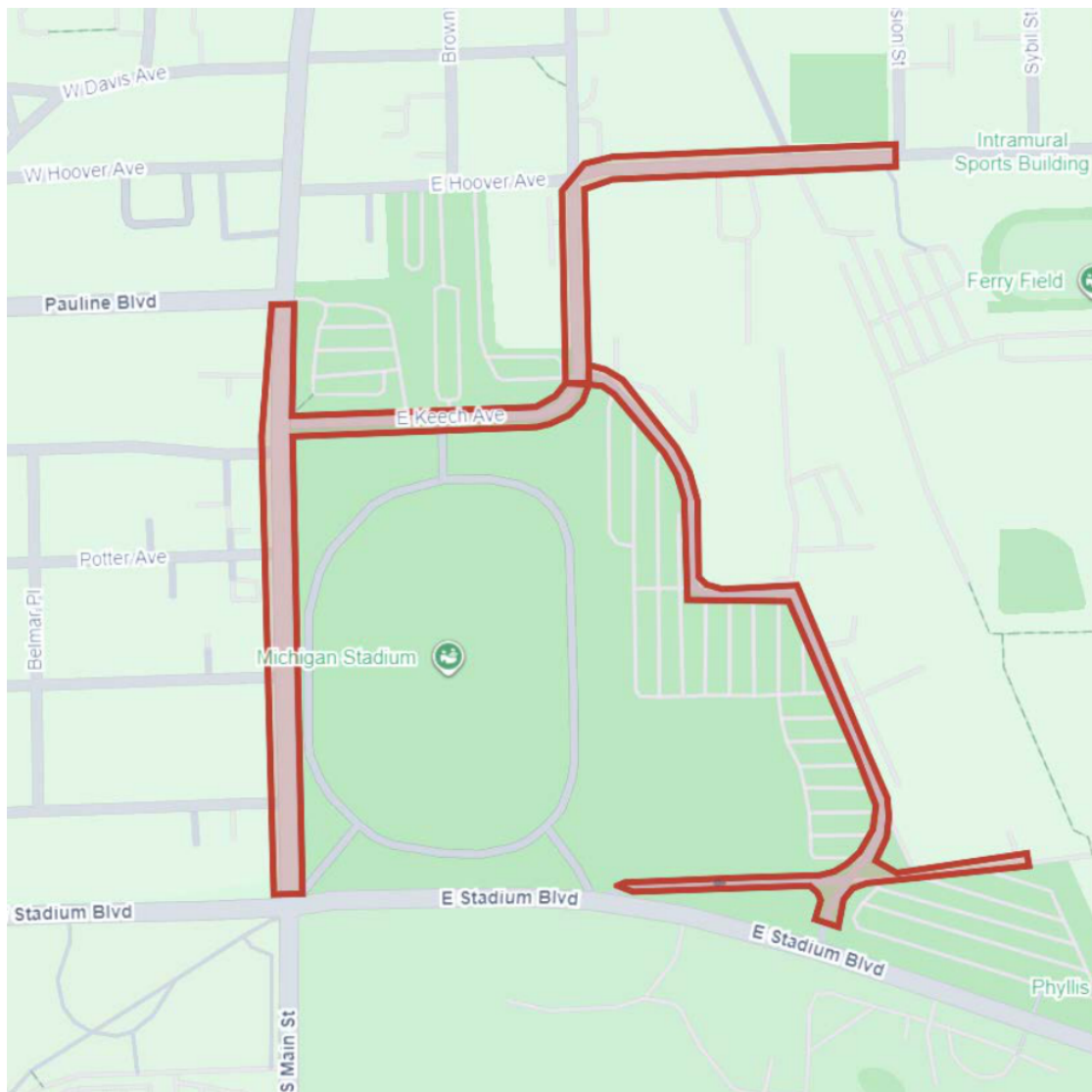
Game Day Closures

Map description

The map depicts road closures in the area surrounding Michigan Stadium in Ann Arbor. Closure areas are outlined in red. Michigan Stadium is shown near the center-left of the map. The map includes portions of South Main Street, East Stadium Boulevard, East Keech Avenue, East Hoover Avenue, and streets and access roads east of the stadium near the Intramural Sports Building.

The red outline is the visual indication of the closure area. The map also labels nearby landmarks and streets, including Michigan Stadium, Ferry Field, the Intramural Sports Building, Pauline Boulevard, Potter Avenue, and South Main Street.

These closures will occur for all U-M home football games. The scheduled closures are the same as those during the past several football seasons:

East Keech Street between South Main Street and Greene

Closure of the westbound right turn lane of East Stadium Boulevard onto South Main Street just south of Michigan Stadium

Closing South Main Street to both local and through traffic from Stadium Boulevard to Pauline

New to 2026 season: E. Hoover Street will close between S. Division and Greene Street starting 90 minutes before kickoff. Greene Street south of E. Hoover will close at the same time. Access will be allowed for parking pass holders in Lot SC32 on Greene Street. Blue Lot pass holders arriving after this time should plan to access the lot via E. Stadium Blvd.

The duration of these closures will be three hours prior to each game until the end of each game. The exception is southbound South Main Street, which will be closed one hour prior to the games until the end of each game. University of Michigan home football games are scheduled for Saturdays:
